- ✓ Counter-protest to Organizing for America, Westlake Mall Plaza, Seattle. We were outnumbered – 2,000 of “them” and only 40 of “us”. However, we were there, we were loud and we were noticed by every single person. We also had opportunity to engage in good debate with many who came over to ask us why we were against reform, and many agreed to examine the issue more closely, and with open minds. - ✓ Counter-protest to Organizing for America, Mercer Island at Dave Reichert’s offices. We outnumbered them by 4 to 1, and completely drowned their voices and their spirits. [Photos](#).
- ✓ Attended various town halls (Norm Dicks, Jay Inslee, Jim McDermott, Brian Baird). The town halls are starting to be dominated by proponents of health-care reform, but only because they are getting exclusive invites and early access to the venues. Our side still has better questions!
- ✓ Participated in a huge Tea Party Health Care Freedom Rally at the Northgate Mall on August 22nd, with a Seeds of Liberty table, petitions, informational handouts and over 80 hand-made signs for all to use. [Photos](#).
